Over time, we have been blessed with many volunteers and in-kind gifts in establishing the memorial garden. Currently we are at a place where we are still looking for financial sponsors to help with covering the ongoing care expenses like engraving names, mowing, electricity, water, etc. We were short \$3,199.42 of our income to meet expenses for 2023. For example, if we had thirteen individuals donating \$20 or more per month, we would be out of the red.
